

## **2010**

2/19/10 – City Council approves legislation adopting the proposed Smoky Hollow Community Development Plan, authorizing the City to acquire, thru eminent domain, 8 vacant parcels in Smoky Hollow, where title was unclear and ownership not identifiable;

2/24/10 – Mayor Williams states that the City will participate as a non-federal sponsor on the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers grant, and agrees to provide the non-federal financial match required under the US ACE agreement;

5/10 – WNI learns that the City will not honor its financial commitment to secure the US ACE funds. WNI agrees to provide the entire required non-federal contribution to the project.

5/19/10 – WNI negotiates an agreement designating YSU, park property owner, as fiscal agent for WNI's Ohio Department of Natural Resources grant of \$396,000 for Harrison Common;

6/2/10 – Ground-breaking for Harrison Common park construction project;

10/29/10 – Substantial completion of Harrison Common including plaza, pergola, inlaid maps, lighting and landscaping.

## **2011**

1/10/11 – WNI receives a \$40,048 contribution from The Rotary Club of Youngstown towards Harrison Common enhancements, including the pergola, granite plat maps, historic marker, pizza oven and culinary herb garden;

4/28/2011 – WNI moves its offices to St John's Episcopal Church, 323 Wick Avenue, Youngstown, Ohio, 44502;

6/10 – Ongoing negotiations between WNI and YSU on reconfiguring the partnership;

7/9/11 – Ribbon cutting ceremony and dedication of Harrison Common, including an evening event in the park; The Youngstown Jazz Festival.
